Implats is a leading producer of platinum group metals (PGMs). - Complying with the applicable water-related legislation and water-related obligations at all its managed and joint venture operations
- Acknowledging shared responsibility of water resources, which is essential to business sustainability and the wellbeing of the communities in which we operate
- Implementing and integrating water stewardship across operations and the surrounding areas
- Executing strategic and operational decisions informed by water constraints and targets
- Being transparent and constructive in interactions with its broader stakeholder universe regarding water-related issues
- Efficiently and effectively optimising water use, and promoting recycling opportunities to ensure the use of recycled water is prioritised at operations
- Ensuring that initiatives are in place to achieve water targets, and publicly reporting on progress against these targets
