UPDATE ON WORK STOPPAGE AT IMPALA RUSTENBURG

The focus of the meeting was to encourage dismissed employees to reapply for their positions. Both parties agreed to work together towards the achievement of this objective.</p> <p>Impala already embarked on the process of rehiring dismissed employees on Tuesday 7 February 2012. Initially the process focused on recruiting rock drill operators (RDO's) and other stoping workers. All other categories of dismissed employees are now able to reapply for their jobs and it is expected production will resume as soon as the appropriate number of RDO's have been obtained.
